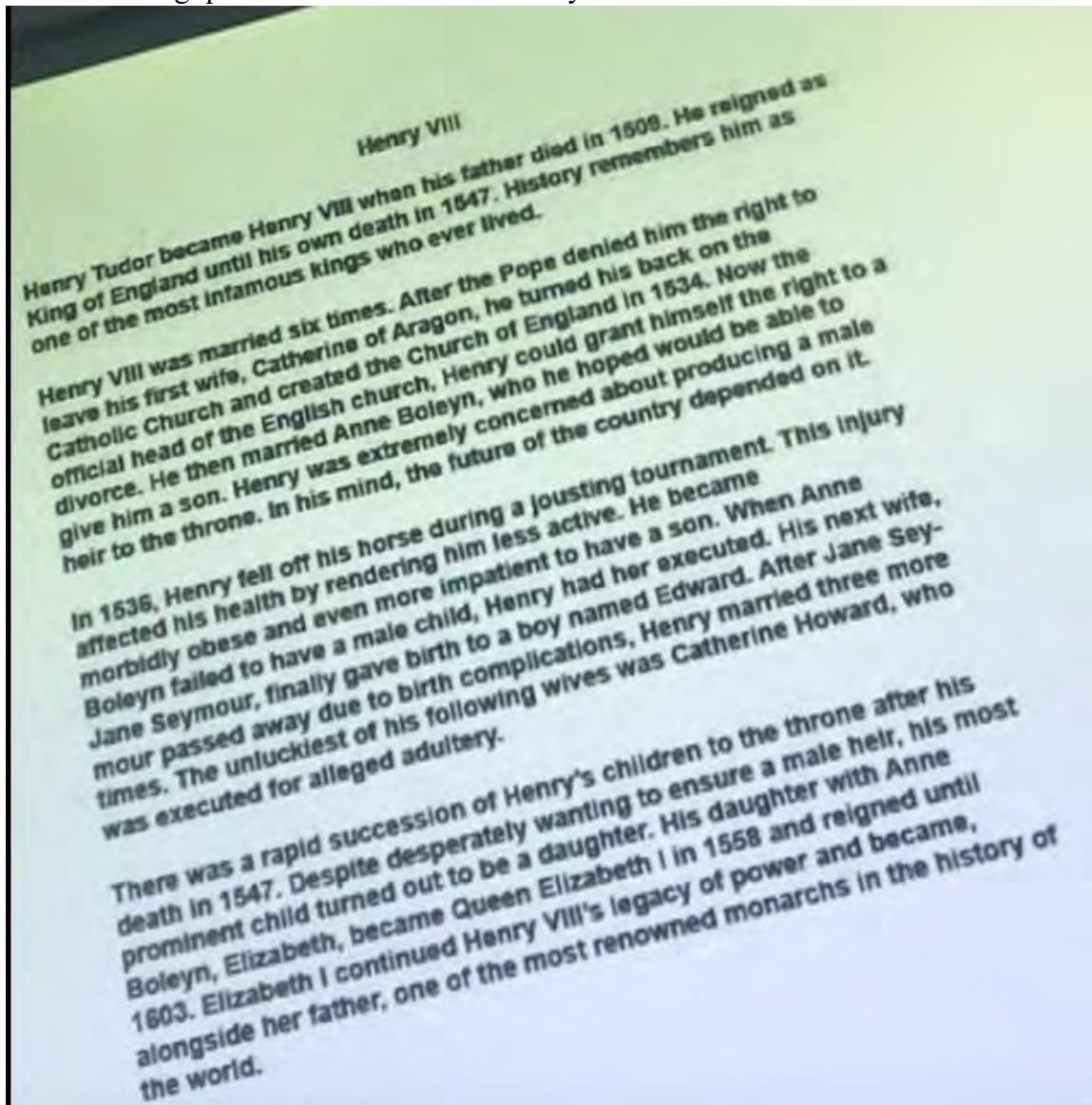

3. The Object of the Game: The player who first moves all of her pieces from her HOME to her GOAL of the same color wins.
